To keep the public informed as to the status of the deaf as a class and eradicate the erroneous idea that they are a "liability."

To suppress quack doctors and others claiming to be able to restore speech and hearing. To suppress impostors, feigning deafness, who prey on a credulous public.

To seek the enactment of uniform State legislation requiring doctors and practitioners to report to the proper State authorities each and every case of deafness, met with in the course of practice.
